FÁY ANDRÁS FOUNDATION

The OK Project is a unique educational project in Hungary maintained by the OTP Fáy András Foundation, residing in the 6th district of Budapest. In the last five years – through our special training-based methods – we taught more than 100 000 students. The experts of the OK Project taught students how to manage their finances and how to handle everyday life's monetary issues to become financially responsible grown-ups. During today's event the trainers of the OTP Fáy András Foundation will hold an interactive exercise. The aim of the exercise is to reveal our financial risk-taking skills and give useful examples about proper money management.

AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL

The Hungarian section of the international organization addresses the question of the refugee crisis through its interactive workshop named „What would happen if...?”. During the game, the participants form families who find themselves in a war-situation, and have to make decisions on what will they do and how will they escape. At the end of the workshop, they get the opportunity to talk about the issues that have emerged through the situation. Therefore, not only will your sensitivity be evoked, but at the session you will have the chance to discuss the problems themselves.

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

Ms. Dorka Bauer (Climate Reality Leader in Hungary) and Mr. András Volom (first UN Youth Delegate of Hungary), former students of our school and BIMUN veterans will moderate a conversation (involving the audience) about Sustainable Development Goals.

LGBTQ

Homosexuality and cognition. This workshop is held by LGBTQ people who will clarify the misunderstandings and misbeliefs with the help of playful situational games about association and discrimination. There will be a significant emphasis on informal talk and exchange of ideas at the end of the workshop.

EKINT

This workshop is a situational game in the topic of constitutionality. The participants with pre-distributed roles are not familiar with any information other than the frame of the story. They perform a debate representing their preferences, while they have to make decisions on how to use their time limit. According to the basic concept, the participants are shipwrecked on an uninhabited island. Due to the randomness of the cast, the participants have to disregard their personal background, and have to put themselves into minds of characters, such as: a captain, who wants to capture power; a first class passenger, who demands for excess aliments; a worker, who bought a ticket to the second class; or the university professor. The company has extremely varied faces from the stowaways to the missionary, who refuses to eat fish, because of consciencious reasons. So, the task is to argue from the point of view of your role. At the end of the game, you can discuss the story's moralities on demand.

COMMON GROUND

How history is made? In this revolutionary event we will explore how revolutions are made. This won't be a speech, but instead we will start actual revolutions. Most of us have been either directly or indirectly affected by a revolution. Even if you grew up in a safe country, has it always been safe in the past? Let's discover that together on the joint event of Common Ground (Közös Halmaz) and Budapest Bridge. Let's make history together!
